## December 9, 2020 Part II

- GUSD sent a counterproposal to GTA at 5:14 pm today.
- GUSD continues to insist on a **mandated** return to work on campus for ALL counselors, nurses, and Teacher Specialists starting **February 1, 2021** because it would be "helpful." Earlier, at the table, GUSD was not able to give a satisfactory rationale why those members could not continue to fulfill their duties remotely.
- GUSD continues to propose that site-based Teacher Specialists be "repurposed" to serve as "additional support" by being added as cohort members to Special Education classrooms. Special Ed Teacher Specialists would be required to work on multiple campuses.
- Earlier today, GTA proposed extending the MOU until we are out of the Purple Tier and the COVID infections are no longer "widespread." GUSD's counter-proposal only extended the Distance Learning MOU to Friday, **February 12, 2021.**

## GTA asks:

- Will it be safe to return in February?
- Will we be ready to work without a Distance Learning MOU?
- Why is LAUSD protecting all students and employees by shutting down all campuses, but GUSD is not? Why is BUSD allowing all members to CHOOSE whether or not to work on campus for the rest of the school year, but GUSD is not?
- Why are only *some* members being mandated to return to campuses? Do they think they can divide us? Is this a union-busting tactic?
